## WRABNESS PARISH COUNCIL

### Minutes of the meeting held on Wednesday 8th January 2020 in Wrabness Village Hall at 7.30pm

2846 Minutes of the meeting held: on Wednesday 20th November 2019. The Minutes were agreed as a true record and signed.

#### 2847: Matters Arising and Actions:

i: **Traffic Wheatsheaf Lane (2830)** Parish Clerk contacted school bus operator Panther Travel Ltd last week, who conformed no known incidents has occurred with lorries from the depot since last meeting. Ms R Thornton reported that the school bus had to reverse back to the main road to allow a lorry from the depot to pass, on the afternoon of 21st November.

Update: Ms R Thornton: Contacted Essex Highways Liaison Officer and explained the Parish Council have an issue with the size of the lorries. Response from Essex Highways: The lorries cannot be rerouted so an option is for the Parish Council to liaise with local businesses to see if small vehicles could instead be used. This is an impractical suggestion as the site is a bulk storage depot served by HGV's. Ms. Thornton has emailed Essex Highways Liaison Officer.
