1. Wrabness Environmental Award:

Each year Wrabness Parish Council welcomes nominations for a hard-working, community minded person or group of people to receive the Wrabness Environment Award. The Wrabness Environment Award is an attractive wooden bowl, locally handcrafted, with engraved shields added year on year to record the annual winner chosen for their contribution to the well-being of our community.

The Wrabness Youth Club are the 2025 winners of the Wrabness Environment Award. Some of the Youth Club organisers were in attendance to accept the award. . In 2023, the Youth Club was launched. This was a welcome initiative in the village, with Wrabness Parish Council providing a start up grant in support. The Youth Club continues to provide a safe space filled with opportunity for children from Wrabness, Wix and the surrounding area on Friday evenings while also providing social opportunities such as residential trips.
